



What do you get when you combine fall's cozy weather with fun backyard activities like watching movies and gathering around a firepit? You get great reasons to make sure your home's Wi-Fi network is equipped to support your networking needs beyond your walls.

Just imagine how wonderful it would be to have fast and reliable Wi-Fi signals outside, so you can work on your laptop from the patio or enjoy streaming movies with your family on the deck or porch.

The ability to extend your indoor wireless signal to the great outdoors depends on how far you want that Wi-Fi signal to reach — whether just to the patio or all the way to the far end of a large backyard. For short distances, you can try moving your router as close to your yard as your Ethernet cable will take you, but that may not be enough.

Many households have an indoor mesh Wi-Fi system that comes with one router and one or two mesh devices. Are you one of them? Since these systems typically cover up to 5,000 square feet, you may be able to get the outside Wi-Fi coverage you want by moving one of the mesh devices to an indoor space (such as the garage) near the part of your yard you want covered.

In some cases, adding an additional mesh device may be needed to achieve the desired outdoor coverage without sacrificing Wi-Fi speed or coverage inside your home. It can be simple to add a mesh device, since it only needs an electrical outlet to plug in the power adapter, and no Ethernet cable is required. There are other equipment options available, including units designed to be used outdoors on exterior walls.

If you've recently logged in to your bank, set up a new phone, or tried to access a government website like Social Security, you've probably encountered MFA, or Multi-Factor Authentication. It's becoming a standard security measure across nearly all online accounts—and for good reason.

What Does MFA Do?

Multi-Factor Authentication adds an extra layer of protection to your accounts. Instead of relying only on a password (which can be guessed or stolen), MFA requires you to provide an additional proof of identity. This might be:

- A one-time code sent by text or email
- An app-generated code
- A fingerprint, face scan, or security key

Why Is It Important?

Cybercriminals are constantly looking for ways to access personal information. MFA makes it significantly harder for them to break into your accounts, even if they know your password. In fact, using MFA can block over 99% of automated hacking attempts.

Where Will You Encounter MFA?

Be prepared to use MFA in an increasing number of situations, such as logging into online banking, accessing your phone carrier account to change or upgrade a plan, setting up a new phone, signing in to government sites such as Social Security and IRS portals, and managing subscriptions or utilities online.

How to Be "MFA Ready"


Take these steps:

- **Keep your contact info current.** Make sure your phone number and email on file with your providers are up to date.
- Know your methods. Some accounts may send a code by text, while others may require an authentication app. Download and set up these tools ahead of time.
- **Be patient.** Extra steps may feel inconvenient, but they protect your identity and your data.

Don't use real words. Password cracking tools can process every word in the dictionary until a match is found. Instead, use uppercase and lowercase letters combined with special characters such as "&" or "#."

Create longer passwords. The longer it is, the better. Try for at least 10 characters.

Don't use the same password for multiple websites. If one website has a data breach and you've used that password elsewhere, it's easier for hackers to steal more information.

Change your passwords. Get in the habit of changing them twice a year when you reset your clocks for Daylight Saving Time.
